Photos and Filming

Spectators are expected to cheer and support their team positively, while avoiding any behaviour that may be deemed aggressive, abusive, or threatening towards the opposition, referees, or other spectators.

Photography and filming policies are also in place to ensure the privacy and safety of all those involved in the matches. Spectators are welcome to take photos or videos of the matches but must do so in a way that does not interfere with the game or compromise the privacy of individuals.

The club requests that all spectators adhere to the following guidelines when taking photos or videos:

- 1. Only take photos and videos from designated areas where it is safe to do so, and without obstructing the view of other spectators or the game officials.
- Seek confirmation from team representatives before taking photos or video of any players, as well as respecting the wishes of anyone who does not want to be photographed or filmed.
- 3. Avoid the use of flash photography or excessively loud camera noises, which may distract or interfere with the players, officials, or other spectators.
- 4. Refrain from sharing any inappropriate or offensive images or videos, especially those that may compromise the privacy or dignity of individuals.
